






## **Reflections 2020-2021**

Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi in the early days of the Covid – 19 outbreaks had directed the country's top scientists in and outside the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) to expand testing facilities besides putting the country under complete Lockdown. We will always remember Prof. Dr. B.S. Chavan, Director/Principal, Government Medical College, Sector 32 whom we lost during covid pandemic. He was a dedicated doctor whose presence and involvement could be felt in all our Covid preventive strategies despite his illness.

I am extremely happy to be a part of the prestigious Military Literature Festival, an annual feature organized jointly by the Government of Punjab, Chandigarh Administration and the Western Command ChandiMandir. With the concerted efforts of all it has become the world's largest Military Literature Festival in a Short period of four years. This time, the fourth edition, because of the pandemic, was inaugurated virtually by Hon'ble Defence Minister of India, Sh. Raj Nath Singh Ji and was widely attended all across the world.

Given the rich martial traditions of the region of Punjab, it comes as no surprise that this region is a treasure cove of military events since times immemorial, thus simmering in unlimited tales of military invasions, campaigns and battles with the natural abundance of battlefield heroics, sacrifices and events that's steered the course of not only the region, but the country as a whole.

The Third Volume of the Coffee Table Book- The Reflections - 2020 is an attempt to highlight the achievements for this period together with the accomplishments of the preceding year.






Teacher training is of utmost importance, especially in this day and age where change is the only constant. But, do we want to put our teachers through numerous training sessions or have them

The segregation of waste at source is being extended to the entire city to make the city a bin free city for which the Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh is going to purchase about 300 vehicles in additions to 99 already purchased and deployed in 13 villages recently transferred to Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh and various markets of the city.




